Al Mamoun Suite



The name of this Exceptional Suite is a reminder that the history of La Mamounia dates back to the 18th century, when Prince Al Mamoun received a sumptuous thirteen-hectare orchard from his father as a wedding gift.

It is to the splendour of that era that the décor pays homage, an expression of supreme luxury with its carved wooden ceilings, chiselled plaster friezes and zellige mosaics.

Majorelle Suite

Overlooking the flower-filled Gardens, swimming pool and Atlas Mountains, the Majorelle Suite spans 114 m² and comprises two bedrooms. The first features a double bed; the second two singles facing a rotunda-style window whose views beckon you to gaze out over the hotel Gardens. The suite also boasts two bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub.

In homage to the artist, Majorelle blue punctuates the décor of the suite, enlivened by touches of orange and enhanced by shimmering zellige mosaics.



The result is a timeless atmosphere, beautifully incorporating contemporary touches, in which to savour the finest of champagnes and spirits.







Le Cinéma



Two centuries later, La Mamounia hotel was born, and went on to become a legendary palace, the only one in the world to bear a female name.

Les Lanternes




Marking a transition between the swimming pool and the restaurant, the Italien by Jean Georges, these three new spaces create a harmonious visual surprise.
