





A UNIQUE LUXURY HOTEL IN MARRAKESH

The journey continues in the corridors of La Mamounia, which magically reproduce the Medina's narrow streets. Behind the characteristic wooden doors that preserve our guests' privacy lie 135 rooms and 71 suites, where the quintessence of Moroccan craftsmanship is expressed in all its splendour, alongside impeccable contemporary decoration.

For an even more singular experience, our three riads are ideal for either a family or a group of friends seeking private accommodation.

Hivernage Classic Twin Rooms

Located between the garden level and the first floor, facing the hotel's main entrance, the Hivernage Classic twin rooms are decorated in a refined Moroccan style that blends wood and tadelakt with rich fabrics.

With sizes ranging from 28 to 40 sq. m, the neutral tones dominate richer colors, creating a sensation of calm and tranquillity, while sculpted wood illustrates the magnificence of local craftsmanship.

The Hivernage Classic twin rooms offer 2 twin beds and a beautifully designed bathroom with a separate bath and shower.



Deluxe Rooms

Spread throughout all floors of the hotel and decorated in a Moroccan style, the Deluxe Rooms are characterised by their panoramic views and private outdoor spaces. They all boast a terrace with a connecting door.

Whereas the Koutoubia Deluxe rooms afford a privileged view of the famous 12th century mosque, the Park Deluxe rooms promise a unique view over La Mamounia's luxurious gardens.

Yet more spacious and located on the upper floors, the Agdal Deluxe rooms overlook the swimming pools, gardens and historic Agdal neighbourhood. In the distance, the Atlas Mountains magnify this unparelleled setting.

Hivernage Superior Rooms

Located between the hotel's second and fourth floor, all Hivernage Superior Rooms enjoy a view of the Hivernage residential neighborhood with a size ranging from 28 to 40 sq. m.

Balance and harmony are the watchwords of these enticing rooms that place an emphasis on neutral, soothing tones accentuated with a touch of color – a vast frieze of traditional zelliges.

The Hivernage Superior Rooms offer a king size bed and a beautifully designed bathroom with a separate bath and shower.

The Suites



Bathed in light, our 65 Suites and 6 Signature Suites subtly embody the gentle way of life in Morocco, combined with the refinement and elegance of contemporary decoration.

From the bed linen (Porthault) to the terry bathrobes (Garnier Thiebaut), not to mention the soft carpeting and ultra-luxurious fabrics, all the facilities in our luxury Suites and the impeccable details invite our guests to take time out for themselves.

Decorated with marble and punctuated with zelliges, all our en suite bathrooms have a bath and shower, and are fully equipped. To enhance your bathroom ritual, La Mamounia provides complimentary signature toiletries, whose delicious garden citrus scents will instantly soothe the mind.



Hivernage Suites

Overviewing the main entrance of the hotel, the Hivernage suites are filled with calm and serenity. With a surface size of 85 sq. m and a king size bed, these suites present the impeccable decoration and the luxurious facilities which make the reputation of La Mamounia.

The large living room, the romantic terrace with pergola and the bathroom with separate shower and bathtub, all confer to this suite warmth and privacy.

Park Suites

These suites offer a bedroom with a large king size bed, a living room with a sofa bed equipped with the most refined tailor-made furnitures and a beautifully designed bathroom with a separate shower and bathtub.

Located on the hotel's middle floors and close to the main elevators, the Park suites offer a size ranging from 55 to 70 sq. m with a panoramic view over La Mamounia's legendary gardens and the Atlas Mountains.










Agdal Suites

With a captivating view over the swimming pool, the Agdal Suites offer the beauty a Moroccan interior with the ultimate modern comfort.

The Agdal Suites subtly embody the sweetness of Moroccan life mixed with the refinement and elegance of contemporary decoration. Ranging in size from 55 to 60 sq. m, they feature finely decorated bedrooms, balconies, a king size bed and a distinguished bathroom with separate shower and bathtub.



Executive Suites

The quintessence of Moroccan craftsmanship, the Executive Suites are all decorated in a traditional spirit where elegant details emulate luxurious materials.

With a surface area of 70 sq. m, the Executive Suites boast a terrace with an unobstructed view of the gardens and the Atlas Mountains.

Sumptuous and comfortable, the Executive Suites invite our guests into the heart of oriental refinement for a relaxed stay in a class of its own. Only the room sizes and views vary, offering guests an even more personalised experience.

Duplex Suites

Ideally located with a size of 75 sq. m, the bedroom offers either a king size bed or two double beds and is opened onto a private terrace in the midst of lush gardens, with special access to the swimming pool.

The combination of marble and Moroccan style gives to the bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub, a soothing atmosphere.

Located at the hotel's garden floor, the Duplex Suites benefit from an upper-level terrace and an elegant living room decorated in colors inspired from the spices of the market. Deep red, saffron yellow and striking green bring warm tones to the contemporary, refined decor of these airy suites in harmony with nature.



Prestige Suites

Situated between the 2nd and 4th floor, the Prestige Suites offer a panoramic view from their terraces over the luxuriant gardens and snow-capped Atlas Mountains.

Offering one bedroom with a king size bed, a distinguished bathroom with separate shower and bathtub and two living rooms in which one has a sofa bed for more privacy, these generously sized luxury suites of 100 sq. m are all decorated in a contemporary style.

Showcasing a subtle interplay of zelliges, rich fabrics and sculpted wood, the Prestige Suites make up an elegant ensemble where charm and sophistication come together.









Koutoubia Suite

This space that tends towards intimacy reveals opulent touches of Moroccan craftsmanship.

With tiled zellige walls and sculpted wooden ceilings, the Koutoubia suite has a rotunda living room in the "Menzeh" style that offers a spectacular view over the Koutoubia mosque.

Situated on the 3rd floor of the hotel, the Koutoubia Suite is a bright and airy space with multiple windows that unveil the mysteries of Marrakesh.

Comprising one bedroom with a king size bed, one living room and two bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub, this vast suite of 109 sq. m is decorated in beige tones with traditional wooden furniture.



Churchill Suite

A replica of the statue in London, a portrait of the great man with his cigar, and the engraving of his name above the bed are just some of the nods to this personality dotted around this luxury Suite, where tartan armchairs and Moroccan furniture cohabit with grace.

The spirit of Winston Churchill reigns over this signature suite that bears his name.

Overlooking the gardens he loved to paint during his stays at La Mamounia, this spacious suite of 107 sq. m is composed of two bedrooms with a king size bed and two double beds, one living room and two bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub.

Baldaquin Suite

Overlooking the swimming pool, the Baldaquin Suite comprises a bedroom with a king size bed, a living room and two bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub. The Baldaquin Suite of 77 sq. m is an idyllic and elite heaven for lovers. The marquetry work is remarkable, and the walls display portraits of married couples dressed in traditional costums, suffusing this suite with a romantic spirit, ideal for celebrating unforgettable moments.

The Baldaquin Suite owes its name from the sumptuous bed, upholstered in white taffeta, which takes pride of place in the center of the room. The tone is set in this vast signature suite that celebrates love in a subtle interplay of ivory and cream shades. There is no red or traditional colors, the neutral tones enhance the refined decoration, which – from the floor to the hand-painted ceiling – exudes a soothing, radiant aura.



Majorelle Suite

Comprising two bedrooms with a king size bed and two double beds, a living room and two bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub, the Majorelle suite overlooks the flower garden, the swimming-pool and the Atlas Mountains.

Designed as a tribute to the famous painter Jacques Majorelle, whose portrait is displayed at the entrance, the Majorelle Suite captivates with its vibrant colors and textured fabrics.

The blue – the artist's favorite color – is embellished by mosaics of shimmering zelliges and vivid splashes of orange in the suite's two bedrooms that extends on 114 sq. m.

Marqueterie Suite

Wood reigns as a master and warms up the beige fabrics that cover the walls of this suite with a subdued atmosphere. While elegant wood paintings depict traditional scenes of Moroccan life, the vintage furniture of 1920s sublimates this luxury Suite with pure and rigorous lines.

Outside, the terrace offers a privileged view over the gardens, while the Atlas Mountains rise up from far away.

Unique by its distinctive Art Deco furniture, the Marqueterie Suite is the second most spacious of La Mamounia' suites with 155 sq. m comprising two bedrooms with a king size bed and their own bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub and a spacious living room.

Al Mamoun Suite

Comprising two bedrooms with a king size bed and two double beds, two bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub and a spacious living room, the Al Mamoun Suite of 212 sq. m is ideal for those who are seeking space and privacy.

Transfixed, the gaze settles on two Chinese vases framing the wide French windows that open onto the terraces. Rising up in the distance, the Atlas Mountains enhances this Royal oasis.

The Al Mamoun Suite is a destination of its own.

Rooted in the history of La Mamounia through its name and princely decoration, the Al Mamoun suite is an antique lover's dream.

Furnished with paintings and works of art from around the world, its multiple influences and unusual decoration create a perfect alchemy between the Orient and the Baroque period.



The Riads



Settled around a patio, these typically Moroccan settings, wonderfully cultivate the art of discretion and privacy. Inside, the dining room, the living room as well as the three bedrooms with king size beds, two double beds, private bathrooms with separate shower and bathtub, are decorated in the same luxurious and opulent style as our most beautiful suites.

In a private setting deep in the heart of La Mamounia's gardens, three elegant Riads with a surface area of 700 sq. m offer a privileged and unique experience while benefiting from several personalized services of the hotel.

Each of our spacious Riads has a heated swimming pool and a private terrace, and can accommodate six guests.



L'Asiatique par Jean-Georges




A FLAVOURSOME AND SOPHISTICATED MENU

Every day, great classics and new releases are screened in this cosy and comfortable setting, where viewers can indulge in Pierre Hermé popcorn and snacks.



A DIALOGUE BETWEEN NATURE AND ARCHITECTURE



The Hammams




LA MAMOUNIA HAMMAM IN MARRAKESH – TREAT YOURSELF TO A MEMORABLE EXPERIENCE


